## The Psychology Clinic

The University of New South Wales **Psychology Clinic** was established as a Community Psychological Facility providing clinical psychological services to adults, children and families who are experiencing psychological, emotional or behavioural problems. The Clinic also functions as a facility to provide advanced post-graduate training in Clinical Psychology within the School of Psychology and is staffed by intern psychologists working under the supervision of consultant clinical psychologists and neuropsychologists.

The **Psychology Clinic** employs an approach to the assessment, treatment and management of psychological problems based on the most up to date evidence and research emphasizing treatment evaluation. The Clinic maintains close liaison and consultation with referring agencies and other mental health services.

## Clinical Services

The **Psychology Clinic** has established itself as a leading provider of focused therapy, primarily cognitive and behavioural therapies for adults, children, young people and families. The Clinic provides psychological assessment and therapy for a range of problems including:-

- ◆ General anxiety disorders,
- ◆ Phobias,
- ◆ Depression,
- ◆ Post-traumatic disturbances,
- ◆ Obsessive-compulsive disorder,
- ◆ Panic Disorder,
- ◆ Eating and dieting disturbances,
- ◆ Insomnia,
- ◆ Health anxiety,
- ◆ Conflict and anger problems,
- ◆ Marital or relationship problems,
- ◆ Occupational rehabilitation and stress management,
- ◆ Health related problems,
- ◆ Disruptive and oppositional behaviours such as aggression in children,
- ◆ Childhood sleep disturbances,
- ◆ Other psychological problems of childhood.

## Group Programs

As well as providing individual therapy The **Psychology Clinic** offers a number of Group Therapy programs. Currently these programs are for adults with Social Phobia or Panic Disorder and for children with various anxiety or social skills problems.

## Neuropsychological Assessments

The **Psychology Clinic** provides neuropsychological assessment and rehabilitation services for appropriately referred clients suspected of having acquired brain damage. For appropriate referrals the Clinic can undertake assessments of cognitive functioning and learning disabilities.

## Other Services

The Clinic also provides consultancy and advice to Government, Public and Community Agencies and other organisations in mental health related areas.
