

## Catch Up Vaccination Advice for GPs (refugees/missed dose at school/other)

Service Providers who require vaccines for the catch-up vaccination of refugees/immigrants, children in the appropriate age group who missed out on vaccination at school due to illness or absence and other individuals as indicated, must order the following vaccines for these eligible groups by contacting their local [Public Health Unit](#) (unless otherwise indicated):

Vaccine	Eligibility
<b>ADT</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Refugees Only</li> </ul>
<b>Boostrix</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Children in <b>Year 7 and Year 10 only</b> who missed out on vaccination at school</li> </ul>
<b>Hepatitis B (Adult)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Refugees</li> <li>Household contacts of acute and chronic hepatitis B carriers</li> <li>Sex workers, people living with HIV, men who have sex with men, injecting drug users</li> <li>Catch up of Aboriginal persons 20 years of age or older</li> <li>Clients of sexual health services, opioid programs and s100 prescribers#</li> </ul>
<b>Hepatitis B (Paediatric)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Refugees</li> <li>Catch up of Aboriginal children under 20 years of age</li> <li>Children in <b>Year 7 only</b> who missed out on vaccination at school</li> <li>Catch up of children less than 7 years of age born overseas</li> </ul>
<b>Human papillomavirus</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Female students in <b>Year 7 only</b> who</li> </ul>

<b>(HPV)</b>	missed out on vaccination at school
<b>IPV</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Refugees</li> <li>• Catch-up vaccination of children</li> <li>• Immunocompromised individuals and their household contacts</li> </ul>
<b>MMR</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Unvaccinated individuals born in or after 1966*</li> </ul>
<b>Meningococcal C</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Unvaccinated individuals up to 25 years of age*</li> </ul>
<b>Varicella</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Year 7 children who missed vaccination at school due to illness or absence</li> <li>• Year 7 children who are 14 years old who require a second dose following school program vaccination</li> </ul>
